The guidance should include information on how to design, implement and measure the impact of the approach and engagement with the affected communities. It should have direct applicability for the decisions humanitarian agencies need to make when designing sanitation in the early stages of an emergency.

Summary of opportunity	<u>Purpose of RFP</u> To fund research necessary to inform and design interventions to 1) cure HIV, defined by the eradication of all pathogenic virus from the body, or 2) bring about a state of remission whereby the virus is controlled in the absence of ART and the person is no longer infectious.

	<p><u>Specific areas of interest</u></p> <p>In order of priority:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Proof-of-concept clinical studies testing cure interventions 2. Disabling or eradicating the HIV reservoir 3. Discovery and targeting of novel mechanisms to disrupt HIV reservoir persistence <p><u>Expected outcome</u></p> <p>Research findings that provide strong preliminary data that inform next-stage clinical or preclinical studies testing curative interventions.</p>
